



Declaration of permission for a travel document

Declaration of parent(s)/parental authorities/legal guardian

PLEASE NOTE: To obtain a passport, minors need permission from their legal guardians; in many cases this means both parents. To obtain a Dutch identity card, permission is required for minors younger than 12 years of age.

A clearly legible copy of a valid passport, valid identity card or valid driving licence for the person or persons giving written permission must be submitted together with the completed and signed declaration. The signature must be clearly legible; otherwise it cannot be verified and the permission will not be accepted.
